

**Art Club:** Students meet once a week to work with a variety of art materials and explore the elements of art. Students will express themselves creatively and learn together as they engage in hands-on art activities.

**Amazing Athletes:** This extracurricular is led by an outside vendor. Amazing Athletes meets once a week to focus on nutrition, physical fitness, movement and athletics. Students will do activities from a variety of sports which may include baseball, basketball, football, golf, hockey, lacrosse, soccer, tennis, track and volleyball.

**Basketball:** Students meet twice a week to learn the rules of the game and work on a variety of basketball skills. In addition to drills, students will work toward playing on a team and in games. This basketball program is designed for elementary students. Participation includes a DSA basketball jersey.

**BBA Basketball:** We have a new outside provider for basketball for 1st-6th grade. BBA is endorsed by NBA players and provides a skill-based program for improving players' performance. Students will only scrimmage other students in the program

**Bookworms:** Students meet once a week for this after-school literacy program. During each session, students will read, discuss, and create around a theme connected to high-quality children's literature.

**Brazilian Jiu-Jitzu:** Students meet twice a week to learn a powerful skill that teaches kids self-defense and even promotes anti-bullying, both teaching children to defend themselves against bullies and to avoid bullying others. Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu (BJJ) is a grappling-based martial art whose central theme is the skill of controlling a resisting opponent in ways that render the opponent harmless.

**CBF Soccer School:** This extracurricular is led by an outside vendor. Students meet twice a week to work on developmental soccer skills. This high-energy program will introduce boys and girls to fundamental soccer principles, covering: physical

conditioning, technical abilities, tactical concepts, key psychological factors and the understanding of the rules of the game.

**Code With Us:** This extracurricular is led by an outside vendor. Students meet once a week to learn to code using Scratch coding on iPads. Students will also receive a log in to access the coding program at home outside of coding class.

**Cross Country:** Elementary students will develop long distance running techniques and stamina.

**Dancing Little Stars of SE Florida:** Dancing Little Stars teaches ballet and tap. Our trademark curriculum is designed to make dance class fun and exciting! Additionally, our program will teach your child how to follow directions, memory skills, learn about rhythm, coordination, and balance. Our mission is to provide every child with the opportunity to dance and build a foundation they can be passionate about for a lifetime.

**Flag Football:** Elementary students meet once or twice a week depending on their grade level. Students will learn the basics of football, practice football skills and drills, and scrimmage each other at practices. \*Students in 3rd through 6th grade will have the opportunity to participate in an end of season tournament if there are enough students to field a team on that date.

**Getz Arts Drum Club:** For elementary students, Getz Arts Drum Club offers a fun and engaging group activity designed to give young students the chance to explore the percussive arts. Students learn the fundamentals of rhythm class-and-response, word-play, patterns, and movement.

**Golf:** This extracurricular is led by an outside vendor. This is age appropriate golf skills with age appropriate golf equipment provided by the vendor. Students do not need to bring any of their own golf equipment. Golf classes will be held outside.

**Music Club:** Students meet once a week to develop a love and appreciation for music and singing. Students will practice many musical skills, interpret emotions and song meaning, and sing a variety of songs.

**Piano:** Individual piano lessons will be offered for students grade 1 and higher on a first come, first served basis. Students have weekly piano lessons and participate in an end-of-year recital.

**School Play:** Led by our 1st grade teacher, Mrs. Abigail Baehman, and Kindergarten teacher, Miss Abby Mehlberg, students meet twice a week to work on theatrical skills. Students will practice skills like: public speaking, facial expression, listening, and creative expression, as they prepare to put on a theater show. Students are also

needed for the stage crew, set design, and prop creation. Tryouts will be held to determine roles when the group meets.

**DSA Team Soccer:** Led by our 2nd grade teacher, Mrs. Jen Chojnacki, and 4th grade teacher, Mr. Dayne Kopfer, students meet once a week to work on soccer skills. Based on the earlier survey, there does not appear to be enough interest to participate in the Tampa Soccer tournament this year, so the 3rd-6th grade team will just work on building their soccer skills as a school team looking forward to a more competitive season next year.

**Soccer Shots:** This extracurricular is led by an outside vendor. Soccer Shots offers an engaging soccer program for children with an emphasis on skill-building and character development with trained and experienced coaches. Early childhood students will participate in their Classic program and elementary students will be able to participate in their Premier program. Soccer Shots meet once a week.

**STEM Club:** STEM is an approach to learning and development that integrates the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics. Through STEM, students develop key skills including problem solving, creativity, critical analysis, teamwork, independent thinking, initiative, and communication. Students will investigate a scientific question and use everyday materials to derive solutions with a team of other students. They will also be introduced to STEM-related occupations.

**Techie Kids Club:** This extracurricular is led by an outside vendor. Techie Kids Club meets weekly to do age-appropriate activities related to coding, robotics, and gamification.

**Tennis Time:** This extracurricular is led by an outside vendor. Tennis Time meets once a week. Students will develop their tennis skills by learning forehands, backhands, serves and volleys, all while playing games and having fun! Tennis Time provides the nets, age-appropriate racket sizes, and low compression tennis balls.

**Track:** Students meet once a week to train for various running, jumping, and throwing events. Students in Grades 3-6 will participate in two track meets.

**Writing Club:** Led by our 1st grade teacher, Mrs. Abigail Baehman, students meet twice a week. Writing club gives students a chance to strengthen their writing abilities in a fun and engaging way. There will be a variety of topics and activities presented throughout the quarter in order for students to practice outlining, editing, and revising each writing piece.

**Yearbook:** This extracurricular led by our 4th grade teacher, Mr. Dayne Kopfer, will meet once a week to put together our school yearbook. Students will utilize the TreeRing website to design the yearbook and include pictures taken throughout the

school year. At the end of the school year, the yearbook will be printed and distributed to all students.

**Yoga Eaters:** Led by an outside vendor, DSA parent & PTO president Amanda Haar. Good food and Christian yoga adventures for balanced, strong kids. Through interactive stretching, poses and nutrition, kids can build strength, focus, mindfulness, athletic performance and recovery, emotional regulation, confidence, and health. This yoga class is taught from a Christian perspective with God's Word infused into why it is important to care for our bodies.

**Chef's Club powered by Yoga Eaters:** Led by an outside vendor, DSA parent & PTO president Amanda Haar. This class focuses on cooking and tasting nutritious, delicious recipes together! We will learn various cooking skills as we prepare a different recipe each week.
